Dear Valued Customer,

BioSpectra shall notify all active customers of any changes to our GMP products by providing written notice at least six (6) months prior to the date the change will take effect, unless the change is considered an emergency. Any emergency Change Control Notice shall be delivered to the Customer as soon as it is commercially feasible. Customers are considered active if they have purchased a product within the last twenty-four (24) months, unless otherwise agreed upon.

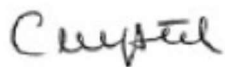
Change Control notifications shall be provided for the following change types in accordance with the BioSpectra Change Control procedure, DCN: BSI-SOP-0084, and IPEC Significant Change Guide for Pharmaceutical Excipients Version 5:

- Manufacturing Process
- Product Specifications
- Raw Material
- Components
- Manufacturing Location
- Part Numbers
- Packaging Configuration
- Labeling
- Discontinuation of Product
- Ownership and/or Company Name
- Change in test methods (if not compendial)

Any further requirements related to change notifications can be addressed in a Quality Agreement with BioSpectra.
